Jim Clark Revival – April 27-30, 2006

- World record attempt to be taken into the Guinness Book of World Records with 1000 classic cars built up to 1976
- International race series with over 500 cars at the start

(Hockenheim, December 7, 2005) After a successful premiere in 2005, the "Jim Clark Revival" starts again on the last weekend of April 2006 with even more participants, even more international race series and a spectacular world record attempt.

An attempt will be made to be taken up into the Guinness Book of World Records with a gigantic historic car line-up on the Grand Prix course of the Baden Motodrom on the Saturday evening (29th. April) of the event. Hereby up to one thousand (!) historic cars should fill up the asphalt course. Chief Organiser Ronny G. Bredhauer: "We call upon all Classic-Automobile-Clubs to participate in this unique and exclusive action. This will be without doubt one of the absolute highlights of the Jim Clark Revival in 2006. The interest is enormous, already now we have more than 500 entries."

For the participating Clubs, the opportunity presents itself for them to place their cars in the immediate vicinity of the race course. A large and fortified embankment with enough parking lots and fantastic view surround more than half of the asphalt course. Other than the world record attempt, on the whole the Jim Clark Revival offers even more fascinating racing sports on the track than in its premiere this year. The most important of the FIA European Championships in Historic racing sports are there as well. Other than the Ferrari F1 Clienti and the Historic Ferrari Maserati Challenge, the presence of the HGPCA (Historic Grand Prix Car Association) as well – with more than 40 Grand Prix racing cars from the Fifties and Sixties – will ensure a real Formula 1 atmosphere. All in all, there will be more than 500 racing and sports cars from all over Europe competing in the various races. All together it will be pure racing action which one should not miss.

The Jim Clark Revival is held in memory of one of the best racing drivers of all times: The Scotsman Jim Clark, World Champion twice in a Lotus in 1963 and 1965, died in a tragic accident on April 8, 1968 during a Formula 2 race on the Hockenheimring.
