Jim Clark Revival vom 27. bis 30. April 2006

- The Oldtimer line up grows – World record attempt with 1000 historic cars up to 1976 for the Guinness Book of World Records
- Twelve international race series at the starting line
- Four days of pure action on the Motodrom of Hockenheim

(Hockenheim, January 2006) New entries are being sent in daily: The world record attempt with over 1000 historic cars up to 1976 are creating a stir in the scene. 600 vehicles have already been registered.

The world record attempt of the “largest rolling automobile museum of the world” planned to take place on Saturday 29. April 2006 during the four-day-long Jim Clark Revival on the Grand-Prix course of the Hockenheim Motodrom, is already now creating a great stir of interest in the scene even three months before the event. “Since the beginning of the year, the telephones have been ringing constantly. We receive new registrations every day,” reports Ronny G. Bredhauer, the Chief Organiser.

Amongst the numerous automobile clubs that have already registered for the Jim Clark Revival with their members are for example: BMW M1 Club, Cobra Club, Dino Owners Club, Ferrari Model Club and Ferrari Club Switzerland, International Lamborghini Club, Jaguar Association Germany, Lancia Stratos Club, Lotus Club Deutschland, Lotus Club Europa and the Pantera Club Schweiz. The clubs and all others who are participating in the world record attempt are offered the attractive opportunity to place their cars in the immediate vicinity of the race course with the best overall view of all that happens on the track. A large and fortified embankment with extensive parking possibilities surrounds more than half of the race course. In 2006 again, the Jim Clark Revival offers with a total of twelve international race series on the course, fascinating racing sports. Due to the enormous starting field, the event programme is heavily extensive on all four days. To name a few: the Formula Vau, the European Formula 2 Club and the Recaro Formula 3 Cup right up to the various FIA European Championship series for GT- and Touring Cars as well the strong-powered racing cars of the Orwell Supersports Cup will be participating. And even the Shell Ferrari Historic Challenge has agreed to start at the Jim Clark Revival. In addition, the historic Formula 1 race cars of three decades of the Sinsheimer Company, Interrace will also be at the starting line.

Pure racing action is guaranteed – and all this for very pleasant family friendly admission fees. The weekend cards costs 25,- Euro, young people up to 16 years of age enjoy free admission to the Jim Clark Revival.
