Jim Clark Revival, April 27 to 30, 2006

- Jim Clark would have turned 70 on March 4
- Enormous Club area behind the Mercedes Tribune
- Attractive admissions fees especially suitable for families
- End of April date will also remain fixed for future years

(Hockenheim, March 1, 2006) Race driver Jim Clark would have turned 70 on 4. March which is on Saturday of this week. The Jim Clark Revival will be held the last weekend of April in remembrance of the two times world champion.

In just its second year of existence, the Jim Clark Revival is already becoming the second largest Oldtimer Event in Germany with more than 400 historic racing and sports cars participating. But if one also counts the over one thousand Oldtimers which will be participating in the attempt for the Guinness Book of World Records "The largest rolling Automobile Museum of the World" on Saturday, (29 April) the late afternoon of the event on the Baden-Württemberg racing track as well, then the Jim Clark Revival will most probably be the largest Oldtimer event held worldwide in 2006.

The "Technische Hilfswerk" will also be involved actively, since the line-up and the following driving on the track will most probably take place until darkness. The whole Grand-Prix-Course will be completely brightly lit up with huge retractable spotlights. Due to logistic reasons, the mutual meeting point for the participating vehicles of the various Oldtimer and Automobile Clubs for this exciting world record attempt has been moved to the large area just behind the Mercedes Tribune. The Chief Organiser, Ronny G. Bredhauer says: "The vehicles will stand here on firm grounds even if the weather is not all that good, the participants will have short routes to the entrance of the paddock and the Tribunes. Furthermore, a large catering centre with numerous drinks and food stalls will be set up in the middle of the area."

The admission fees for the four-day-spectacle are especially suitable for families – the weekend ticket costs 25,- Euro; young people up to 16 years of age are admitted free of charge. Moreover families that live in Hockenheim will even receive a voucher for 2 free admission tickets. They all can expect a programme filled to the tilt during the four days. Together with the Historic Formula 1, the European Formula 2 Club and the Recaro Formula 3 Cup right up to the various FIA European Championship series for Historic GT- and Touring Cars and the thundering racing cars of the Orwell Supersports Cup, one of which will most probably race the fastest lap of the weekend. Moreover, the date for the Jim Clark Revival will be fixed firmly upon the last weekend of April for future years.
